The Town of Mahon lies at the South East end of the Island of Minorca. The Island was taken from the Spaniards in 1708, by Major General Stanhope. It is 8 miles long and 1 1/2 broad. Cittadella is the chief City, but the place of greatest strength is St. Philip's Castle, a square Fort of 4 Bastions. The Harbour is one of the safest and most commodious in the Mediterranean, and will contain a great Number of Ships being 4 miles in length and above half a mile in breadth.
