LOYAL TROOPS AND REBELS FIGHT FOR THE  
CAPITAL.

HUNDREDS KILLED IN STREETS.

These pictures, the first received from Madrid, were flown direct from the Spanish Capital to London.

Large forces of workers armed by the Government, and loyal troops clashed with rebels in the streets of the Capital, objective of the rebel forces. Columns of rebels are marching on the city and loyal troops have been sent to meet them.

PHOTO JUST RECEIVED SHOWS:- Civil militiamen, protected by a barricade & mounted a machine gun and fired upon the rebels, in front of the Montana Barracks in Madrid.
