





Looking haggard and weary, carrying their few possessions with them, refugees from Barcelona arrive at Port Vendres, south of Perpignan, France.

Two French destroyers brought 513 of them to the port from the war area. They had been sheltered in the French Embassy at Madrid, but were removed to Barcelona because of the food shortage in the capital.

They will now be accommodated in a holiday camp at Port-Vendres.
