THE BATTLE FOR THE HILL OF THE ANGELS.  
REBELS DRIVEN OUT - THEN RETURN.

A desperate struggle is still going on for possession of the Hill of the Angelax, the vital position south of Madrid, which was captured by Government troops in a surprise attack but from the summit of which they withdrew before a fierce rebel counter-attack. The battle is continuing on the slopes of the Hill with Government artillery constantly shelling the road beyond to hinder the arrival of insurgent reinforcements.
