MADRID REDS FIRE ON FUNERAL

Three young Fascists were killed and many people wounded in Madrid, Spain on Thursday when Communists in an empty house opened fire with an automatic gun upon the funeral procession of a Civil Guard, who had been killed when firing began on Tuesday last. It was believed that it was intended to assassinate Senor Gil Robles, the Catholic Leader, who was in the procession.
