GARRISON CALLED OUT WHEN PRISONERS FIRE
CARTAGENA GAOL AFTER SPANISH ELECTIONS.

Mutiny broke out in the prison at
Cartagena, Spain, after the Spanish
general elections.

Nine hundred inmates, among whom were
many political prisoners, overthrew
the guards, killing a warder, and
then set fire to part of the building.

Two warders were taken as hostages.

Troops of the Cartagena Garrison were
called out to crush the revolt.
